GameTime Training

GameTime training is committed to providing quality instruction. Our desire is to teach kids how to kick the ball correctly, how to pass, and how to get in sync with muscle memory. Our soccer season will be designed around knowing the essentials of soccer to better prepare them for success in their future leagues - we also just plain have fun! Game days will take place on Saturday mornings, and we will have a practice day scheduled in advance.

Our soccer facility will allow us to work on other athletic aspects of the game of soccer. This year each team will have their own coach that will set the practices for that team.

At the end of the day, GameTime Training is not only focused on soccer but on God-Centered results. We desire to pour into your young athlete, so that as they learn the game, we can invest in their character on and off the field.

Season Information

Each registered athlete will get a GameTime Jersey, shorts, and socks. Each team will have a scheduled practice day and we will use Saturdays as our game days.
