HIGHLIGHTS



There has been a 200% growth at Celebrate Recovery. The CR team provides 50+ weekly meals for the CR family.

New Cov Young Adults is growing and doubled in size.



There were 80 T-batters, 70 soccer players, and 3 trainers in GameTime Sports, also involving Break the Barriers and Clovis Youth Football.



There were 900 women in attendance, 160 volunteers, and 6 co-host churches at Jennifer Rothschild's Fresh Grounded Faith Women's Conference in April.

83 adults and students have been baptized.



165 people attend weekly Connect Groups.

89 women attend weekly women's Bible studies.

69 men attend Friday early morning Bible study.



The SMC received a \$55,000 renovation.



The Men's Ministries Golf Tournament had 118 players and raised \$16,000 with proceeds benefitting Molly's House.
