

FINANCIAL REPORT

This year, our financial achievements include successfully managing the budget by keeping expenses 6% below our income. Additionally, we maintained our commitment to fully supporting foreign, national, and local missionaries, along with their respective mission projects. Furthermore, we expanded the church staff to meet the needs of new and existing ministries.

Moving Forward

As we anticipate the upcoming fiscal year, our aim is to boost our budget by 3.2%. We plan to elevate our yearly missions contribution to \$39,000, aligning with our objective of allocating 10% of our total budget to support local and global missions.

We are eager to complete Phase 1 of our Doubling Down construction project, which involves enhancing the front courtyard area and finishing the baptismal. Exciting developments await us in 2024/2025!
