**It's Raining, It's Pouring...**

*And Noah did **all** that the Lord commanded him. Genesis 7:22*

*The animals going in were male and female of every living thing, as God had commanded Noah. Then the Lord shut him in. Gen 7:16

*Then Noah built an **altar** to the Lord and, taking some of all the clean animals and clean birds, he sacrificed burnt offerings on it. Genesis 8:20*
